

Town of Apple River, Polk County Wisconsin

VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT for the April 2nd 2019 Spring Election

Any qualified elector who is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place on Election Day may request to vote an absentee ballot. A qualified elector is any U.S. citizen, who will be 18 years of age or older on Election Day, who has resided in the Town of Apple River for at least 10 consecutive days before the election. The elector must also be registered in order to receive an absentee ballot. Proof of identification must be provided before an absentee ballot may be issued.

REQUESTS FOR ABSENTEE BALLOT

- 1. Absentee Ballots must be requested in writing.** You may request an absentee ballot by using a form or by writing a letter.

To receive a form:

- Call the clerk at 715-554-0441 (you can receive it in person, through mail or email).

- Download it from <http://elections.wi.gov/forms/EL-121-english> (also available in Spanish and Hmong).

Letter:

- Your written request in the form of a letter must list your name, voting address within the Town of Apple River, the address where the absentee ballot should be sent, if different, and your signature.

- 2. Submit absentee ballot requests (form or letter) with proof of identification:**

Thursday March 26th, 2019 5 pm is the deadline for requesting to receive an absentee ballot by mail or email.

Note: Special absentee voting application provisions apply to electors who are indefinitely confined to home or a care facility, in the military, hospitalized, or serving as a sequestered juror. If this applies to you, contact the Town Clerk, regarding deadlines for requesting and submitting an absentee ballot.

VOTING AN ABSENTEE BALLOT IN PERSON

You may complete and submit a request for absentee ballot with proof of identification and vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office in person. Contact:

Monday, March 11th, 2019 is the first day to vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office

Monday, April 1st, 2019 5:00 p.m. is the last day to vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office

No in-person absentee voting may occur on the day before the election.
