

TOWN OF APPLE RIVER
REGULAR MONTHLY BOARD MEETING
Monday, April 11, 2022

The April Regular Board Meeting of the Town was called to order at 7:00 pm by Chair Bryan.

All present: Chair Bryan, Supervisor Johnson, Supervisor King, Treasurer Carlson, Clerk Agne, and Planning Commission Chair Steve Arduser.

Approval of Meeting Agenda: Chair Bryan inquired if everyone had reviewed this evening's agenda. Hearing no comments, Chair Bryan asked for a motion to approve the agenda. During review it was determined to remove the Amery School Board Referendum, since it was completed, from the agenda. A motion to approve the agenda by Supervisor King, as amended. The motion to approve was seconded by Supervisor Johnson. A voice vote was called. Motion approved.

Approval of Minutes: The draft minutes from the Regular March Board Meeting were reviewed. A motion by Supervisor King to approve the minutes of the March meeting as submitted. The motion to approve was seconded by Supervisor Johnson. A voice vote was called. Motion approved.

Public Input: None.

Clerk's Report: Reported Board of Appeal contacts, working on annual financial document due May 15.

Report by Treasurer: The Treasurer's March Report was presented by Treasurer Carlson. A motion by Supervisor King was made to accept the Treasurer's Report as given. Motion seconded by Supervisor Johnson. A voice vote was called. The motion carried.

ARPA: No new information is available.

BIL – Ideas as possible projects need to be "green", bridges, high speed internet, and new Fire Hall.

Apple River Solar: No new update. Project pushed back 2024 or 2025.

County Report: Steve Arduser reported that the County has a comprehensive remodeling project underway, including new windows and LED lighting through the end of the year. Elizabeth Haas has left the Zoning Office.

Vouchers: Vouchers were reviewed. Chair Bryan discussed requesting a relief on snow plow bill. The Chair called for a motion for the approval the vouchers as presented. A motion by Supervisor King to approve the vouchers as proposed. Motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Johnson. A voice vote was called. The motion carried.

Supervisor Reports: Supervisor Kerry noted that 110 Street is coming apart, 120th is also in poor shape. Need to schedule the Road Tour, take photos and keep history on Kerry's laptop. Kerry take the East half of town, Chad the West. Supervisor Johnson suggested roads are in fair shape, winter not too bad. He suggested for patches to use slurry coat over black top as more flexible and lasting.

Supervisor King stated that the Ambulance Director reported onetime grants for emergency services. He updated the board on the tractor rental for brushing with Archie Serwe Implement, equipment not available but should be soon. He noted building permit violations for 1649 100th Street.

Town Planning Commission Chairman, Steve Arduser noted the commission tabled discussion on a Rezone Request for 1787 County Road I from A10 to B3, Commercial.

Supervisor Kerry updated the Board on the adjacent property purchase, Brian Burns, Attorney is on board. Phase I study to start tomorrow. New revised purchase document with be out soon.
