

TOWN OF APPLE RIVER
REGULAR MONTHLY BOARD MEETING
Monday, June 13, 2022

The June Regular Board Meeting of the Town was called to order at 7:00 pm by Chair Bryan.

All present: Chair Bryan, Supervisor King, Treasurer Carlson, Clerk Agne, and Planning Commission Chair Steve Arduser, and Danny Wilson and spouse, Nick's Trucking representative. Supervisor Johnson not present.

Approval of Meeting Agenda: Chair Bryan inquired if everyone had reviewed this evening's agenda. A motion to approve the agenda as prepared was made by Supervisor Bryan. Motion to approve was seconded by Supervisor King. A voice vote was called. Motion approved.

Approval of Minutes: The draft minutes from the Regular May Board Meeting were reviewed. A motion was made by Supervisor King to approve the minutes as submitted. The motion to approve the May Minutes was seconded by Supervisor Bryan. A voice vote was called. Motion approved.

Public Input: None.

Clerk's Report: August 9 Partisan Primary Election work is under way. ARPA funds are scheduled to be sent this month.

Report by Treasurer: The Treasurer's May Report was presented by Treasurer Carlson. A motion by Supervisor Bryan was made to accept the Treasurer's Report as given. Motion seconded by Supervisor King. A voice vote was called. The motion carried.

ARPA: Second installment of funds were sent from the State. No other additional information.

BIL – June early funding round underway. The Town has three projects are in the works for future funding cycle.

Apple River Solar: No update.

County Report: None.

Vouchers: Chair Bryan read the vouchers. The Chair called for a motion for the approval the vouchers as presented. A motion was made by Supervisor King to approve the vouchers as proposed. Motion to approve seconded by Supervisor Bryan. A voice vote was called. The motion carried.

Supervisor Reports: Chair Bryan held highway discussion for later in meeting with Nick's Trucking rep. Supervisor King reported that the rented brushing tractor was returned last Friday. A map of the work completed serves as a record.

Fire Department/EMS: May FD Run Report submitted via text message, see at end of minutes.

Highway Department: Danny Wilson, Nick's Trucking and Excavating updated the board on the work he will do for the Town.

Planning Commission Chair Steve Arduser noted that the County Zoning Ordinance addresses junk vehicles as a problem. The Town does have a Nuisance Ordinance adopted in February of 2018. The Clerk will locate this documents and post them if they are not already on the website.

Cemetery: Additional solar lights were installed to light the flagpole. The flag was completely tattered and was replaced.

Prochnow Assessing Contract for 2022 thru 2025 was discussed. A motion to approve made by Supervisor King. Chair Bryan seconded the motion to approve. A voice vote was called. Motion carried.

Final review of Northwestern Municipal EMS Bylaws and Contract occurred. A motion by Chair Bryan to approve the bylaws and merger as submitted was made. The motion was seconded by Supervisor King. A voice vote was called. The motion carried.

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Annual Liquor License Applications were reviewed. Motion by Chair Bryan to approve the applications as submitted. Motion seconded by Supervisor King. A voice vote was called. The motion carried.

The Driveway Ordinance Fee increase was tabled until next month.

Supervisor Kerry updated the Board on the adjacent property purchase. The purchase agreement was signed earlier today, following no unusual findings from the Phase I, 164 page report.

Next month items: Driveway ordinance fee increase.

The next regularly scheduled Board Meeting will be held Monday, July 11, 2022, Work Session 6 PM, Meeting 7 PM. The property purchase closing will be held at the work session next month.
